Tam Twirlers Square Dance Club Setup/Clean up Duties (2017)

GENERAL:

All members are expected to help with setup and cleanup on our regular dance nights (Wednesday). To facilitate this, we have created a schedule that assigns each of us a date. If you are unable to make your assigned date, please arrange for someone else to cover (or trade) with you. If you are unable to arrange a trade, please contact the Hospitality Coordinator. If you know in advance that you will be unavailable on specific dates, please contact the Hospitality Coordinator and you will not be scheduled for those dates.

PARTY NIGHTS:

The last Wednesday in each month is considered a party night which may have a specific theme and may require additional help for either setup or cleanup. Everyone is expected to participate by bringing a snack appropriate to the theme. **For party nights without a theme, those people assigned as either setup or cleanup for that month should bring a snack of their liking**

SET UP DUTIES:

Arrive at 6:30pm. Because the Round Dancers start at 6pm, some of these tasks will already have been started.

- Turn on the lights. Switches are on the back wall by the doors on either side or left side of stage.
- Set up the tables: One by the front door for check-in and two on the far side for flyers and snacks.
- Set up folding chairs to define the dance area.
- Put out fans as needed.
- From cabinet (right side of stage, through the door and on the right there is a large cabinet) find the plastic boxes that are labeled:
 - Put out hand sanitizers, cups and marking pens on small table in right front corner (watertable).
 - Put out the water cooler and drip pan on that small table
 - Get ice and water from the bar.
 - Put out flyers on 2nd table on side wall.
 - Leave first table for snacks.
 - Put white board and dry-erase markers in front of caller table.
 - Put setup box and hand sanitizer on check-in table.
 - If it is not a party night put out snacks from the snack box on water table in the bowl with the scoop. Please use open snack containers first.

CLEAN UP DUTIES:

Beginning around 9:30pm (between last 2 tips, or during last tip):

- Empty water cooler and drip pan (outside the back door – but to NOT put ice on the flowers or grass, can use restroom sink).
- Clear water table and surrounding area; wipe clean with napkins.
- Pick up cups and clutter around the room.
- Place flyers and check-in table materials back in plastic box.
- Place all supplies and white board back in the supply closet.
- Help caller break down equipment and carry to car.
- Unplug fans.
 - Return Furniture (tables, chairs etc.) to original locations.
